**NOTICE OF SPECIAL BOARD MEETING  
TOUR OF ENHANCED RECHARGE FACILITIES  
JUNE 16, 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of the San Bernardino Valley Water Conservation District will conduct a special meeting under Government Code section 54956 on June 16, 2025, which will consist of a tour of the Enhanced Recharge Facilities. The meeting will convene at the District's headquarters at 1630 West Redlands Boulevard, Suite A, Redlands, CA 92373-8032, at 1:00 p.m. The meeting will then proceed to a vehicular tour of the Enhanced Recharge facilities within the Upper Santa Ana River Wash, located generally south of Greenspot Road within the City of Highland. The tour is expected to last approximately 2 hours. The tour will terminate back at the District's headquarters, at the address listed above.

The tour will be the only agenda item for the special meeting, and no action will be taken on any other agenda item. The public is invited to attend the tour, and limited public transportation will be made available by the District. Those wishing to take advantage of the District-provided transportation must contact Allison Zecher at the District's offices at 909-793-2503 no later than June 11, 2025, in order to reserve vehicles of sufficient capacity. The District may not be able to meet transportation requests made after that time.

The tour will be conducted in the field at the Enhanced Recharge Facilities located in the Upper Santa Ana River Wash, and will involve travel over sometimes uneven dirt roads, and limited walking and standing on ground with loose dirt, sand, or gravel, or otherwise in natural conditions. All attendees are encouraged to bring comfortable and appropriate footwear, sunglasses, sun protection, and water. Those attendees who may need special assistance in entering or exiting vehicles, or walking or standing over unpaved and uneven surfaces, are encouraged to contact Allison Zecher at (909) 793-2503 by June 11, and the District will attempt to make reasonable accommodations.

While the District makes every attempt to follow all guidance regarding COVID-19 safety protocols, the District cannot assure in-person attendees that they will not be exposed to COVID-19 or persons who have been so exposed. Attendees are advised to exercise caution in limiting their own incidences of exposure, particularly those who may be in groups at higher risk of infection or serious symptoms of COVID-19 if infected.
